With landscapes stretching from the majestic plains of the savannah to the breathtaking coastline of the Cape and wildlife, arguably unsurpassed anywhere on earth, the claim that South Africa is a 'world in one country' seems completely justified. The tour offers a once in a lifetime opportunity to see the Big Five on a safari at the famous Kruger National Park, soak up the unforgettable scenery along the Garden Route, explore Cape Town and discover the beautiful Winelands region.

This document aims to give you all the information that you require for a smooth and comfortable trip to South Africa. Please take the time to read this dossier to familiarise yourself with all the aspects of our tour. It includes important information such as flight details, visa requirements and travel insurance.

DAY 1-2: UK to Johannesburg B

Depart London on your scheduled, overnight flight to Johannesburg. On arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel with a short tour of the city and visit to Soweto, Africa's most famous township.

DAY 3: Johannesburg to Kruger B/D

Journey to Kruger National Park along the magnificent Panorama Route, one of South Africa's most stunning scenic drives. With awe-inspiring vistas, the route follows the impressive Blyde River Canyon, passing plunging waterfalls, spectacular natural landmarks and old mining towns before arriving at your hotel in Mpumalanga.

DAY 4-5: Kruger National Park B

Undoubtedly one of the highlights of the tour awaits today; a guided safari drive in Kruger National Park. One of the biggest, oldest and

quite simply one of the best wildlife parks in the world, Kruger boasts the greatest variety of animals including the famed Big Five. On day five enjoy a day at leisure to relax.

DAY 6: Kruger to Cape Town B

Returning to Johannesburg, fly to Cape Town where you will be met and transferred to your centrally located hotel.

DAY 7-8: Cape Town and Cape Point B

Embark on a fantastic full day tour around the Cape Peninsula. Joining one of the most spectacular coastal drives in the world, Chapman's Peak Drive, travel to the World Heritage Site of The Cape Point Nature reserve where the mighty Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet in harmony amidst dramatic scenery. You will also visit the beautiful marine protected area of Boulder's Beach where the sandy shores are home to a breeding colony of over 2,000 endangered African Penguins. En-route back to Cape Town a stop will be made at the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the beautiful Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, one of the most highly acclaimed botanical gardens in the world. Enjoy day eight at leisure to explore Cape Town at your own pace.

DAY 9: Cape Town to Knysna B/D

After breakfast, transfer to Knysna in the heart of the gorgeous Garden Route to

spend the afternoon relaxing at your hotel.

DAY 10: Knysna and Featherbed Nature Reserve B/L

This morning, take a ferry across Knysna lagoon to the Featherbed Nature Reserve. Stopping at some magnificent viewpoints, your guide will describe the area's fauna, flora, history and shipwrecks, followed by a leisurely guided walk around the area.

DAY 11: Knysna to the Cape Winelands B

Departing Knysna, take the scenic drive to the Cape's beautiful Winelands region. Arriving late afternoon, your hotel is located on the valley slopes, commanding far-reaching views of the surroundings.

DAY 12: The Cape Winelands B/D

Today tour the breathtakingly beautiful Cape Winelands, first stopping at the town of Franschoek, then to elegant Stellenbosch, home to South Africa's most prestigious university. Take some time to explore this delightful town before enjoying a cellar tour and tasting at the award-winning Boschendal Wine Estate.

DAY 13: The Cape Winelands to the UK or Extension B

Enjoy a morning at leisure before transferring to the airport for your flight home, or continue on to your Victoria Falls extension.

Visas

A visa is not required for your trip to South Africa. Further advice should be sought from the applicable tourist authority for other nationalities and for general queries. We strongly advise you check your destinations' Tourist Board or Embassy for the most up-to-date guidelines regarding passport validity.

Insurance

You must obtain suitable travel insurance prior to departure. Mercury Holidays is partnered with Holiday Extras which offer insurance at the following prices:

Tour Guides

This is a fully escorted tour. An English speaking tour guide will be with you on your trip starting in Johannesburg on day 1 ending back to Johannesburg on day 6. Then a new tour guide will join you in Cape Town.

Tipping

It is customary to tip both your driver and guide approximately £6 (100/120 ZAR) per person per day in total and £6 (100/120 ZAR) per person per day for the ranger. Tips will be collected at the end of your tour. Tipping for restaurants (recommended 10%) and the porters at your hotels will be at your discretion. Tips are accepted in the local currency, US dollars, Euros and British pounds.

Health and Vaccinations

It is strongly recommended that you check the latest health recommendations for travel to South Africa with your GP at least 4-6 weeks before travel. It is not advisable to drink the tap water.

Physical Accessibility

This tour is accessible to most people with an average level of fitness and normal mobility. It involves full days of sightseeing, often on foot, and includes some climbing of stairs and getting on and off coaches and boats. **This tour is not suitable for anyone with walking difficulties.**

Group Size

The minimum number of travellers in your group will be 10, and a maximum will be 35. If in the unlikely event there are less than 10 passengers booked on your tour date then you may be asked to change to a different date. A full refund will be made available to you should this alternative not be suitable.

Currency Exchange

The currency in South Africa is the South African



Rand (ZAR). Therefore, it is very important that you budget carefully and ensure you have the right form of currency before you arrive in the country. Cash machines will also be available throughout the tour in order to withdraw money in your local currency.

Personal Expenses

You will need to take some extra money with you to cover any lunches and dinners where these are not mentioned on your itinerary and personal purchases, such as souvenirs, laundry and extra drinks and snacks. Approximately £200-£400 per person will be sufficient for the duration of the tour.

Itinerary Changes

The order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions or for operational purposes. For this reason, we have indicated approximate times only. Your local guide will inform you of any schedule changes as they are informed of them. Some road construction and/or weather conditions may lengthen the driving times. Our intention is to adhere to the day-to-day itinerary as printed; however order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions.




Weather and Climate

Weather can vary quite considerably throughout the year, so please familiarise yourself with the climate charts below.


Average Temperature (°c) Graph for Johannesburg

Visas

A visa is required for entry into Zimbabwe. We work closely with The Travel Visa Company who will be able to arrange your visa on your behalf. Please call them on 01270 250 590 and quote "Mercury Holidays". The cost of the visa is approximately £90 per person. Applications take 10-15 working days to process and are valid for 6 months from the date of issue.

Tour guides

Accommodation and transfers are included for the Victoria Falls extension and there will be a guide with you at times during your stay but there is not a guide with you for the duration of the tour.

Personal Expenses

You will need to take money with you to cover any lunches and dinners, as well as personal purchases, such as souvenirs, laundry and drinks.

The following currencies are widely accepted in Zimbabwe: US Dollar, Euro, Botswana pula, Pound Sterling and South African rand.


