TRIP OVERVIEW

Find yourself at the crossroads of Central and Southeast Europe on this inspiring eight-day tour into Croatia and Montenegro, which also ventures in Bosnia & Herzegovina. Discover the 'Pearl of the Adriatic', Croatia's stunning historic coastal city of Dubrovnik. See iconic Islamic architecture in Mostar and revel in the dramatic coastal setting of Split. Tiny Montenegro brings enormous pleasure, from the beaches of Budva to the Cathedral and cafes of Kotor. The tour abounds with UNESCO World Heritage Sites, awe-inspiring scenery and culinary as well as cultural feasts.

ITINERARY & DETAILS

This document aims to give you all the information that you require for a smooth and comfortable trip to Iceland. Please take the time to read this dossier to familiarise yourself with all the aspects of our tour. It includes important details such as flight details, visa requirements and travel insurance.

DAY 1: UK to Budva D

Depart London on a scheduled flight to Dubrovnik. Be met on arrival and transfer to the beautiful resort of Budva in Montenegro, your hotel base for two nights.

DAY 2: Budva – Kotor – Budva B

This morning set off on a short trip to Kotor, stopping en route at the beautiful little town of Perast, described as "a piece of Venice that has floated down the Adriatic". See its most famous landmark, a man-made islet with a chapel known as 'Our Lady of the Rocks', built by sailors who believed they had encountered a miracle at this spot. Continue on to a tour of Kotor Old Town, an atmospheric delight set between the bay and the mountains. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is characterised by soaring defensive walls, ancient café-filled squares, palaces, churches and museums. Most impressive of all is the Cathedral of St. Tryphon, originating from the 12th century and evolving over time after numerous earthquakes. Marvel at the magnificent Renaissance and Romanesque architecture, with vaulted roofs supported by columns and pillars of pink stone. Don't miss its most valuable treasure, the gilded bas-relief altar screen. Built in honour of the city's patron Saint Tryphon, this is one of only two Roman Catholic Cathedrals in Montenegro.

DAY 3: Budva to Dubrovnik B

After breakfast transfer back to Dubrovnik, Croatia's picture-perfect medieval city which has featured as a backdrop to many a Hollywood production. Today's guided walk around the walled old town, is a cultural and visual feast and takes in the many highlights of the city. Stroll along Stradun, the limestone-paved main pedestrian thoroughfare, which buzzes with bars, cafes and street performers before passing the 14th century Franciscan Monastery at Stradun's west end, which has a beautiful garden and Europe's oldest working pharmacy. Afterwards, proceed to nearby Onofrio's Fountain, built in 1438 to bring water into town via an aqueduct seven miles away. Observe Orlando's Column, carved in the form of the ancient Knight Orlando, and admire the stunning Baroque Church of St Blaise, patron saint of Dubrovnik who saved the city from attack by Venetians. This afternoon enjoy time to explore this awe-inspiring city at your leisure before checking into the hotel for the first of two nights.

DAY 4: Dubrovnik B

Today is yours to discover more of Dubrovnik's attractions at your own pace.

You might choose to walk the iconic 2km circuit atop the city wall, which offers ever changing vistas across the terracotta rooftops of the city and the shimmering Adriatic. A different and more leisurely way of getting equally spectacular views is to take a ride in the cable car, opened in 2010. Alternatively, wander through the Old Town and enjoy its many attractions - historic churches and buildings, medieval sculptures, modern galleries, designer shops, cosy cafes, bars and restaurants - it's all here. On the other hand, there are numerous beaches offering a more laid-back option and a chance to relax.

DAY 5: Dubrovnik – Mostar – Split B

Today, depart Dubrovnik after breakfast and travel towards Mostar in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Acting as the country's central economic and cultural capital, Mostar is an enchanting and fairy-tale like city which boasts a number of picturesque restaurants and markets. View the country's most recognisable landmark, the Stari Most (Old Bridge), an amazing example of Islamic architecture. The restored bridge again connects numerous sights and attractions on both sides of the city, including the mosque, an old style Turkish house and the old bazaar. Ramble over the cobbled streets of the bazaar and immerse yourself in Mostar's local craft shops and traditional restaurants. Journey onwards to Split, Croatia's 2nd largest city and transfer to tonight's hotel.

DAY 6: Split B

After breakfast, explore the vibrant Croatian city of Split. Occupying a dramatic coastal position, Split is a city in which the architecture and surroundings fluctuate between traditional and modern. Tour the grand Diocletian Palace, built as a luxury villa, summer house and military camp for Roman emperor Diocletian in the fourth century and wonder at the palace's majestic Peristyle and golden gate. Afterwards wander down the waterside promenade lined with lively restaurants, shops and cafes, which contrast with Split's medieval centre.

DAY 7: Split – Krka National Park – Split B/D

Depart Split after breakfast at the hotel and travel to Krka National Park and the Skradinski Buk Waterfalls. Located near Šibenik, these 17 stunning falls along the Krka river are one of the best-known natural beauties of Croatia. Get the best seat in the house by embarking on a boat ride across the river, unquestionably the ultimate way to soak in the sights and sounds of the park. Afterwards you can experience the refreshing river waters by taking a quick dip. Depart Krka National Park and stop off en route to relax in the historical town of Šibenik, idyllically located on the banks of the river Krka. Overlook the calming blue waters before returning to Split for a dinner at your hotel.

DAY 8: Split to UK B

This morning, leave the hotel and transfer to Split Airport for your return flight to the UK or onto your chosen extension.

ACCOMMODATION DETAILS & MAP

Accommodation

Your accommodation is selected for convenience, location, comfort or character. Hotel accommodation is generally rated as local three to four-star standard, but please note there is no international classification system for hotels, and differences in facilities and quality do exist between the UK and Croatia or Montenegro. All group tours hotels have private bathroom facilities and air-conditioning, where needed.

Rest assured that all accommodation used by Mercury Holidays is regularly inspected by our staff and partners to ensure that standards meet your needs. If you have booked a triple share, please note that your room will be a twin room with a rollaway bed or sofa bed added. This may limit the floor space in the room.

Meals

Breakfast is always western style and served in the hotel each morning. Dinner (when included) will be taken in local restaurants or at the hotel. A variety of restaurants are visited giving you the chance to experience a range of dishes and flavours.



ON YOUR ARRIVAL

WHAT YOU NEED FOR YOUR TOUR

Visas

A visa is not required for your trip to Croatia or Montenegro (or Bosnia and Herzegovina). Further advice should be sought from the applicable tourist authority for other nationalities and for general queries. We strongly advise you check your destinations' Tourist Board or Embassy for the most up-to-date guidelines regarding passport validity.

Insurance

We strongly recommend that you and all members of your party are suitably insured as soon as you book your holiday. It is a condition of booking that you must have suitable travel insurance. It is important that you purchase travel insurance that suitably covers your participation in whatever activities you may undertake at the time that you make your booking. To assist you with this, we have arranged travel insurance in partnership with Holiday Extras. To arrange your travel insurance with Holiday Extras, please call 0800 781 4237 and quote 'WK830' for preferential rates. Please ensure you provide us with the name of your insurer, policy number and their 24 hour emergency contact number as soon as possible. Sunspot Tours will not be liable for any costs incurred by you due to your failure to take out suitable travel insurance from the date of booking.

Health and Vaccinations

It is your responsibility to check any health and vaccination requirements applicable to your booked arrangements. We can only provide general information about this. Health and hygiene facilities and disease risks vary from country to country. You should take health advice about your own needs as early as possible and in good time before your departure. Sources of information include; www.fco.gov.uk, www.travelhealthpro.org.uk, www.hpa.org.uk, your General Practitioner or a specialist clinic.

Physical Accessibility

This tour is accessible to most people with a good level of fitness and normal mobility. It involves climbing of steep stairs and getting on and off coaches. This tour is not suitable for anyone with walking difficulties. All our tours feature a "Tour Pace" to help find the right holiday for you. To travel on any of our tours requires unaided mobility and the ability to stroll around the sights, climb stairs and get on and off coaches and boats. Our tour paces are marked with dots out of 3, with the differences being as follows:
1 Dot the tour is Easy-Going
2 Dots the tour is Intermediate

3 Dots the tour is Advanced

Croatia & Montenegro is rated as 2 Dots meaning that the tour pace is Intermediate. A good level of fitness is required as you may be on your feet for approximately four hours in a day, though this will be interspersed with regular breaks and will vary from day to day. You will be walking around the sights, and may be getting on and off coaches, trains and boats and climbing steps which may be irregular. You will stay in variety of hotels throughout the tour.

Group Size

The minimum number of travellers in your group will be 12, and the maximum will be 40. If in the unlikely event there are less than 12 people booked on your tour date, we will endeavour to reduce any disruption to your holiday and try to operate your tour with lower passenger numbers. If we are not able to operate your departure date, then you may be asked to change to a different date and a full refund will be made available to you should this alternative not be suitable.

Tipping

It is at your customary/discretion to tip both your driver and guide. We would recommend to tip approximately 2 Euros per person per day. This is a total of €16 per person to budget for tips on your trip. Tips will be collected at the beginning/end of your tour. Tips are accepted in the local currency.

Tour Guides - Local Guides

This is a fully escorted tour meaning that you will be met by a local guide in each of the cities that you visit, ensuring that you have first-hand knowledge at all times.

Currency Exchange

Croatia

The currency in Croatia is the Croatian Kuna.

Bosnia and Herzegovina

The currency in Bosnia and Herzegovina is the Bosnia - Herzegovina Convertible Mark.

Montenegro

The currency in Montenegro is the Euro.

We recommend that you exchange your currency before you leave the UK. It is important that you budget carefully and ensure you have the right form of currency before you arrive in the country. Cash machines will also be available throughout the tour in order to withdraw money in your local currency.

Personal Expenses

You will need to take money with you to cover any personal purchases such as souvenirs, laundry, any meals not included in the itinerary as well as drinks and any additional snacks. Approximately £300- £400 per person will be sufficient for the duration of the tour. It is a good idea to try and maintain a supply of small notes and change in the local currency for tipping or small purchases.

Credit Card Information

As normal practice you may be asked for your credit card details on check-in at the hotel in order to cover any extras incurred during your stay. If you do not have a credit card you may be asked for a cash deposit. American Express, Diners Club,

MasterCard and Visa are widely accepted in hotels.

Itinerary changes

The order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions or for operational purposes. The schedules of the domestic airlines in country are subject to frequent changes. For this reason, we have indicated approximate times only. Your local guide will inform you of any schedule changes as they are informed of them. Some road construction &/or weather conditions may lengthen the driving times. Our intention is to adhere to the day-to-day itinerary as printed; however, order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions.

Baggage Allowance



Each passenger is entitled to 23KG of hold luggage plus 1 item of hand luggage not exceeding (Max 7kg - 56cm/45cm/25cm) in size and 1 personal item such as a handbag, briefcase or laptop case. Weight restrictions will be finalized on E-ticket receipt. Should you wish to take additional luggage you will need to pay extra at check-in. Check-in should be at least 3 hours before departure.

DAY 8: Split B/L

Transfer to the port to board your boat. Upon arrival, enjoy a welcome drink before delighting in the crystal clear waters in one of the bays on the island of Čiovo. After stopping to swim in the bay, cruise towards Croatia's second largest city, Split, where you will disembark to spend time exploring its charming medieval streets and the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Diocletian's Palace. Later, enjoy some time at leisure exploring the beautiful waterside promenade of Riva.

DAY 9: Split to Hvar Island B/L

Head for the island of Hvar, known to be the longest and sunniest Croatian island and a favourite with sailors for over two thousand years. Weather permitting, the cruise will stop en route for a relaxing swim off island Solta, a secluded cove, before arriving at the island's hub, Hvar Town. Spend your evening sampling its hip but laid-back restaurant scene.

DAY 10: Hvar Island to Mljet National Park B/L/D

Today, journey towards Pomena on the island of Mljet, stopping en route for a swim off the island of Korčula. A highlight of the cruise, Mljet is known as Croatia's greenest island with the national park making up almost one third of the landmass. Witness Soline Bay whose narrow passage connects the saltwater lakes to the sea.

DAY 11: Mljet National Park to Dubrovnik B/L

Journey south this morning, stopping for a swimming break at the Elafiti Islands. This afternoon, arrive in the port of the UNESCO-listed city of Dubrovnik, known as the 'Pearl of the Adriatic'. This enchanting seaside city has provided the backdrop to many feature-length films. Explore the Old Town, where all first-time visitors should begin with a walk around the magnificent medieval city walls.

DAY 12: Dubrovnik to Korčula Island B/L

This morning head to Korčula, stopping en route in a bay off the Elafiti Islands for a leisurely swim. After lunch, cruise along to Korčula with time to discover the town and acclaimed birthplace of the explorer Marco Polo. With an impressive old fortress and quaint cobbled streets, Korčula is an idyllic place to spend the evening.

DAY 13: Korčula Island to Brač Island B/L

Set sail along the crystal blue waters for Brač Island, stopping in one of the beautiful secluded bays of this area for swimming and sunbathing. The island landscape of Brač is dominated by a limestone relief, with numerous gullies, crevices, cavities, valleys and coves. Brač is also known for being one of the largest islands in the entire Adriatic Sea.

DAY 14: Brač Island to Trogir B/L

Depart from the island of Brač, stopping for a swim in a bay on the island of Čiovo. Continue to Trogir, a small picturesque town with lot of secrets situated on an island by the Adriatic Sea. Discover the beautiful masterpieces of famous sculptors such as the magnificent Cathedral's portal of master Radovan and the reliefs of master Niccolò di Giovanni Fiorentino. You can find many shops, bars and restaurants throughout this medieval town, a perfect way to spend your final evening before retiring to the boat.

DAY 15: Trogir to UK B

After breakfast on board the boat, disembark and transfer to the airport for your flight back to the UK
